

## CHAPTER XVIII

### TOWN ASSESSOR

SECTION 18.00. Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to confirm the procedure for appointment of a Town Assessor. By adoption of this chapter, the Town confirms its responsibilities under §60.307 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended.

SECTION 18.10. Provisions of State Law Adopted by Reference. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this Code, the provisions of §60.307, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, setting forth the rules and regulations with regard to appointment of a town assessor are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this Code as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 18.20. Confidentiality of Income and Expense Information. Whenever the assessor, in the performance of his or her duties, requests and obtains income and expense information pursuant to §70.47(7)(af), Wis. Stats., or any successor statute thereto, then, such income and expense information that is provided to the assessor shall be held by the assessor on a confidential basis, except, however, that said information may be revealed to and used by persons in the discharge of duties imposed by law; in the discharge of duties imposed by office including, but not limited to, use by the assessor in performance of official duties of the assessor's office and use by the board of review in performance of its official duties; or pursuant to order of a court. Income and expense information provided to assessor under §70.47(7)(af), Wis. Stats., unless a court determines that it is inaccurate, as per §70.47(7)(af), Wis. Stats., not subject to the right of inspection and copying under §19.35(1), Wis. Stats. (The provisions of this Section take effect January 1, 2000.)
