Mark Schmidt moved to recommend approval to Kenosha County a request for a Variance made by THOMAS AND LOUISE DANIELS LIVING TRUST, 1077-248th Ave., Kansasville, WI 53139 (Owner), to construct a detached accessory building to be located in the street yard on Parcel #30-4-220-113-0400.
