

Town of Brighton Stray Dog Protocol

The Town of Brighton will retrieve stray dogs. These are dogs that are found on the road lost. We do not retrieve surrendered dogs. We do not retrieve cats, birds or any other animals domestic or wild. If a large animals or wild animal is found, Lynn Diettrich will have suggestions, but will not be responsible for the care or transportation. If animal abuse is suspected contact the Kenosha County Sheriff Department at 262-656-1234. The town's Animal Control Lead is Lynn Diettrich. She can be reached at 262-496-3332.

Protocol

1. Sheriff Department is notified that a stray dog has been found in the Town of Brighton.
2. Sheriff Department verifies that the location is in the Town of Brighton.
3. Sheriff Department or Kenosha County Dispatch calls **Lynn Diettrich at 262-496-3332**.
4. Upon notification with Lynn Diettrich, dog is transported to the Diettrich Farm

Wisconsin 53168
5. Sheriff Department's work is now completed.
6. The Lynn Diettrich Farm will have housing available to house the dog on a temporary basis.
7. Lynn will secure another volunteer; in the rare incidence she is not available.
8. Lynn will notify the Brighton Town Clerk of the lost dog and it will be posted on the Brighton website. It will also be posted on Lynn's Facebook page along with several others.
9. If unable to find the owner, Brighton will transport the dog to Lakeland Animal Shelter, 3615 State Road 67, Delavan, WI. Phone number 262-723-1000.
